

# **Development and Communications Report**

The areas of Development and Communications continue to be a critical link in connecting the ministry of His Eminence Metropolitan Gerasimos and all our Metropolis ministries with our parishes and faithful. All that we offer is for the benefit of others, and it is important that our message be clearly and regularly conveyed, and that we generate the resources needed to support this ministerial development. The efforts I am blessed to lead in the areas of Development and Communication showcase the many good works of our Metropolis which are outlined below.

## **Communications**

- We continue to produce special video reflection messages from His Eminence Metropolitan Gerasimos for major Feast Days and holidays.
- Our email communications through Constant Contact continue to draw high statistics of engagement with an average of 56% of our messages being read, which is over 10% higher than the industry average. We have over 7,600 people who receive our communications regularly.

We are encouraged that people read our news and engage in our activities and ministries.

- We are grateful for the ongoing support of The Hellenic Journal and the (online) Orthodox Observer, both of whom continue to provide excellent coverage for our Metropolis activities.
- The Metropolis website (<u>www.sanfran.goarch.org</u>) receives consistent positive feedback from across the Archdiocese. Our webmaster, Rev. Father Daniel Triant (Holy Trinity – Spokane, WA) has done outstanding work over the past nine years to manage the content posting and the "backend" functionality of our website.

# **Development**

- The 2023 Faith Forward appeal was once again successful thanks to the generosity of our donors and stewards. In 2023 we raised over \$310,000 this year, without the benefit of a matching donor. We continue to encourage people to become monthly stewards of the Metropolis as it provides a steady stream of income throughout the year, and it is convenient and secure.
- I continue to assist with the All Saints Foundation, and we will be working on a comprehensive fundraising and marketing plan so that we can appropriately brand this initiative and strategically grow this endowment in support of the ministries of our Metropolis.
- I also support the fundraising efforts for Saint Nicholas Ranch and Retreat Center. In 2023 this included coordinating the annual Saint Nicholas appeal, and in 2024 we are working to raise funds for some much-needed technology improvements.
- We have successfully integrated QuickBooks Online with DonorPerfect, which is streamlining gift entry and helping with reconciliation of income through both platforms.

# **Events**

- I have been appointed to serve as the Coordinator the Archdiocese Biennial Clergy-Laity Congress. I meet with the CLC Executive Team on a weekly basis and am supporting the overall planning and implementation of the Congress, with a special emphasis on Fundraising, Volunteers, Hospitality, the Congress Cultural Event, Outreach Programs, and the Grand Banquet.
- The Metropolis Gala was a major responsibility as I served as the staff coordinator for this event. We had an excellent committee under the leadership of George and Christine Psefteas, and overall it was a very successful effort, raising nearly \$485,000 in support of our Metropolis ministries. AXIOS to His Eminence Metropolitan Gerasimos who was honored with the Theofanis Economidis Award for Extraordinary Leadership.

## Ministries

## **Transitions in Ministry Leadership**

- Greek Village Immersion Camp In the summer of 2023, the Metropolis sincerely thanked Katerina Iconomou and Georgia Covel for their many years of dedicated volunteer service as the camp directors. For Katerina and Georgia, Greek Village was a labor of love which reached many young people and their families throughout the Metropolis and beyond. At the same time, the Metropolis is pleased to welcome as the new camp directors, Fr. Christos Kalaitzis and Presvytera Theodora Nakou from Holy Trinity Cathedral in Portland, OR, where they run a very successful Greek school program with approximately 120 students.
- Greek Language and Culture Ministry In the summer of 2023, the Metropolis again expressed its appreciation to Katerina Iconomou for leading this ministry with her Team for the past several years. The Metropolis is pleased to announce that Katerina Chiotis, Director of the Holy Cross Greek School in Belmont, CA, is the new lead of this ministry.
- Folk Dance Festival The Rev. Gary Kyriacou served as the Chairman of the Board of Trustees for FDF since 2011. FDF is now an event of approximately 4000 individuals. In December of 2022, Fr. Gary was assigned as the Proistamenos of St. Sophia Cathedral in Los Angeles, CA. With his increased responsibilities, Fr. Gary will no longer serve as Chairman of FDF but will remain on the Executive Committee as the Director of Ministry. Michael Syrengelas and Spiro Beckas now serve as the Co-Chairs of the Board of FDF and we congratulate them on a very successful FDF 2024.
